

I hope this email finds you well.

I just wanted to give you a heads up that we've received an enquiry from the NSW Fire Brigade Employees' Union (FBEU) querying our fire service volunteer numbers. I'm hoping you might be able to give us some guidance on this issue.

We currently report around 70,000 volunteer firefighters in NSW and this number has been reasonably consistent over the reported time series (RoGS data table 9A.4). The FBEU is querying these numbers, noting recent NSW Budget Estimates which referenced around 40,000 'trained' fire service volunteers. (See page 46 of the transcript:

Are you able to shed any light on how this figure relates to the data we report in RoGS? E.g., is our roughly 70,000 volunteers an aggregate of trained and other volunteers?

Emergency services workforce data, including volunteer numbers, is on the agenda for discussion at next Monday's PEMWG meeting. At the last meeting, members flagged an interest in potentially exploring volunteer numbers further, including, for example, 'active' volunteers. We might fold some of these issues into a broader piece of work for out of session research.


