Submission to the Productivity Commission Inquiry on Delivering Quality Care More Efficiently

IQVIA welcomes the opportunity to contribute to the Commission's inquiry and supports the recommendation to embed collaborative commissioning across Australia's healthcare system.

Our submission is anchored in the attached white paper, *Transitioning to Value-Based Healthcare: A Closer Look at Australia's Progress*. The paper outlines implementation barriers and proposes actionable recommendations to accelerate the shift toward value-based care. These recommendations align with the Commission's emphasis on collaborative commissioning as a mechanism to improve care integration, equity, and system efficiency.

The white paper highlights the need for integrated and patient-focused care models, developed at regional levels to break down silos between primary and tertiary care. It calls for stronger incentives for local health organisations to coordinate care, pool funding, and jointly plan services. It also identifies the importance of evolving funding mechanisms to support high-value care and enable collaborative approaches.

We believe the white paper offers a roadmap for reform and look forward to supporting the Commission's efforts through data, insights, and implementation expertise.

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
