

Creative Industry

I would like the Federal Government to protect, enshrine and maintain our copyright laws for all creative industries - media, art, music, literature, film and television etc.

Copyright and other laws exist to protect rights for intellectual and creative property. Artificial Intelligence (AI) should not be allowed to circumvent these laws which require either significant acknowledgment/payment, or both, for their use or appropriation.
