"Bradfield's origional northern rivers diversion idea was to partially divert flows by pumping water from the east side to the open plains and waterways on the west side of our Great Dividing Range.

The diverted flows were to ultimately drain into Lake Eyre. The NEW Bradfield Scheme does not drain and tip water into Lake Eyre!

The New Bradfield Scheme embraces, improves and builds on Bradfield's philosophies it would use gravity to feed water from the to be built, 120m high Hells Gate Dam on the eastern side of the range through tunnels to the arable lands west of the divide.

The water in part, would be used to irrigate an inland area of Queensland, south west of Hughenden.

The area to be irrigated is substantially larger than all of Tasmania. That's big!

Down the track, The New Bradfield Scheme would divert water into the Warrego River the ultimately onto the northern basin/valley of the Murray-Darling System.

River flows from Queensland's northern rivers will benefit firstly Queenslanders then all peoples down stream from our mighty Darling River.
