Thank you for the opportunity to comment.

The VWMA generally agrees with the draft report. Without bringing about a need for over all change the VWMA makes the following observations:

- Waste management policy should focus on the environmental and social externalities associated with waste disposal, not upstream issues.
- Landfill levies- does this encourage proper disposal or is it just a "fund raiser"? Is there enough evidence to show one way or the other?
- Is the correct balance with the landfill levy going back to industry?
- Waste management policy should be guided by best practice approaches to
 policy development, namely that objectives are clarified; all expected costs
 and benefits of different options are considered; and the policy selected that
 gives the best return to the community.
- There is doubt as to Local Government having the role for municipal waste disposal control.
- Zero waste policies are unrealistic.
- Does the public understand the cost benefits of waste disposal/recycling?
- Does Government give enough industry incentives for waste reduction to landfill?
- Regulations will not necessarily bring about better results.
