Hi

As briefly discussed this afternoon, PM&C doesn't yet have a settled view on action following the AAT decision below. We are working with AGS and Counsel to have a consistent defensible approach to the current and expected FOI caseload as well as PII claims before parliamentary committees.

One option which we are considering is for queries which require a response prior to the expiration of the appeal period from the AAT to the Federal Court, to the effect:

The Department notes the decision of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal in *Patrick v* Secretary Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet handed down 5 August 2021. It is not appropriate to comment further while the orders of the AAT are currently stayed, pending the expiry of the appeal period.

This will not be appropriate after 2 September 2021, but perhaps for your back pocket depending on the urgency of your request.
