Having noted the submission by Dr Darryl Biggar to the inquiry into the Economic Regulation of Airports, I would like to submit the attached paper.

Although the paper is written from a European perspective, it does address the issue of stranded assets, which is at the heart of Dr Biggar's paper. It suggests that this problem has been successfully addressed, particularly in the UK, by negotiated bilateral contracts between airports and airlines.
