With particular reference to used cars under the L V Scheme what I intend to do is show how previous practices of both Government and Automotive Industry have stopped independent Australian participation to a significant degree.

This has reduced competition and choice. The Government has:

- Imposed penalties upon businesses that would break them
- Shown little regard to individual circumstances and thus courses financial distress
- Changing eligibility requirements that would negatively impact on the market

The car industry has no loyalty or commitment to the country and has demonstrated this by:

- Denigrating local importers by damaging their image by name calling
- Not responding to a changing market and producing vehicles that would sell
- Called for tax payers subsidies as co-investment which is distortion of the language
