## The need to have highly trained teachers in the 0-3 age group Important we get the first phase of development right because all children's experiences, emotions and behaviours will be carried into the next phase.

Children of this age have such an Absorbent mind and are absorbing all images from the world. They have no filters so they absorb the good and the bad of their environment. If the teacher is highly trained he/she knows to observe and plan for this age group.

Children are growing at such a rapid rate and going through so many sensitive periods for movement and language and a teacher needs to understand this development and how to plan for these areas.

The environment need to be set- up so carefully and this environment needs to stay fixed and not constantly changed as children need so much structure and predictable routine in their lives. They need order and routine to feel safe and secure in their environment. They need an adult who knows how to observe and carefully plan experiences to suit their individual needs.

A teacher needs to have expansive knowledge of child development, expansive experience in how to observe the children and plan for them, expansive knowledge on how to prepare environments suitable for different age groups.

## One important point which needs to be considered in this discussion is the educator. Are we setting our educators up for success if we place them in a situation for which they have not has the education or training?
