Socially valued role

- Good employers respect my skills as: a Qualified Trainer, Actor and Writer

Focus on strengths not weakness

Overcoming Barriers

- Access: to the community is one of the biggest barrier for people with disability because people have different ideas on what is acceptable. For me one step makes it not accessible
- Social attitudes: another big barrier for people with disability is social attitudes. Many employers believe that if I hire a people with disability that they will be off sick all the time when in fact the opposite is true
- Using equipment: the use of assistive technology allows me to work independently with as little assistance as possible
- Government funding: many employers believe it is too expensive to hire someone with a disability, they are unaware that there are government grants and funding available to assist in this area
