- Our annual turnover is \$4517046 (G.P. \$579991)
- Our membership is currently 718
- We employ/contract 23 locals
- Our poker Nett return is \$314654

This club is the Social and Sporting centre of our district consisting:-

- Golf Course
- Two Bowling Greens
- Two Squash Courts
- Fishing Club with Boat
- Table Tennis Tables
- Snooker and Pool tables
- Dance Hall (All age groups)
- Stage facilities
- Function Room

Our revenue comes from membership and club fees, bar takings and our 23 poker machines.

Being a family orientated club we ensure drunken loutish behaviour is not part of our club and is so rare not to be remembered. Problem gambling is not apparent, although we have limited few who play the poker machines more regularly than the vast majority of our members. They could not be classed as problem gamblers.

Our management, staff and signage ensure these problems do not exist in our club.

Outside our own internal clubs our premises are used by over 40 other groups and associations etc. (90% no-charge) such as Lions, Drama, Keep fit, Schools, Hospital Community Days, Council and many others. There is no other facility in our small town to cater for such ongoing groups. Without our Nil or Low cost support these groups would not function as successfully.
