
RSL ATM Facility Proposal Submission concerning the removal of ATMs from licensed gaming venues in Victoria. Providing service with integrity.





ATM facilities would only be available to and accessible by current financial Service, Affiliate and Social members of the RSL who hold an approved RSL membership card. This would include RSL members exercising reciprocal rights.





All ATM's would be located in a designated secure area that can only be accessed by use of a members card, such as a member's only bar, or in the alternative where that is not able to conveniently occur.









- > Access to all restricted areas would be monitored by electronic swipe access panels or card readers.
- > All RSL membership cards shall enable the encryption of the card for members to either be identified as a self excluded person, or in the alternative to be excluded from the use of ATM facilities.
- > All ATM screens would be programmed to provide responsible messages.
- > All ATM's would produce a receipt that will have printed on it a suitable responsible gaming message.
- > ATM's will be programmed only to dispense \$20 notes up to a maximum of \$200.00 in any one transaction and \$400.00 in any one day.
- > The RSL membership card is common across the whole of the Victorian RSL network and any encryption on the card to restrict access will apply to all RSL Sub-Branches in Victoria.









RSL // Greensborough / Entry Foyer Concept








RSL // Watsonia / Members Room Concept

- > Minimum Size 2070mm (L) x 1400mm (W) x 2100mm (H) to be DDA Compliant
- > Modular Anodized Aluminium Frame with toughened glazing to comply with A.S 1288.

- > Statutory Signage located above ATM
- > ATM surround can be used to promote responsible messages via Poster Holder —
- > Electronic Card Swipe required for access by members only -
- > Egress button for exit and emergency discreetly located

- > Vinyl Stripping applied to glazing for privacy. Colour options would be available to suit a variety of interiors (Not Shown in 3D Visual)
