Introduction

As such, we will be focused on commenting on the parts of the Review document that relate to health issues.

Comments

- 1. The Pharmacists Division supports the proposal that applies to Health care on page XLI and page 268 of the Review document. We also support a review of medical workforce issues. We assume the workforce review would cover **all** healthcare professions.
- 2. The Pharmacists Division supports the finalisation of Wilkinson Review recommendations that relate to restriction of location rules for community pharmacies. Attached is the Pharmacists Division's Issue Paper Number 3 on restriction of PBS Approval numbers, that supports our view that these restrictions should be abandoned to provide competition in the marketplace.
- 3. The Pharmacists Division has concerns that the Community Pharmacy Agreement is protected under section 51(1) of the TPA and as such protects practices that may ordinarily be regarded as anti-competitive. Attached is a copy of our submission to the Trade Practices Act review in 2002.
