## RE: RETAILING -INTERNET UNFAIR PURCHASES - NO GST INCLUSIVE

I wish to make a written submission into the inquiry by the overseas retail purchases which are exempt from GST charges which is clearly unfair and puts Australian business and working class at an disadvantage.

The government excuse that it would be too hard to administer a GST charge on overseas purchases is not good enough reason to not levee the GST charge.

The government if it really wanted to could have the companies put a GST charge on their web sites and this could be be connected to the ATO direct so that the GST could be paid immediately on purchase.

The Government should be looking at ways to have the GST placed on purchases with immediate payment to the ATO Reserve Bank account

There is another agenda for the government for overseas purchases and is quite happy to sell out local business and Australia's working classes and this is to have Australians use the internet for purchases as centre of the Australian economy and this is why the Government is placing a computer for every student in every school and also is why the Government is rolling out "Fast Broadband"

By doing this it is placing all their eggs in the one basket and thus risking massive unemployment and a slave economy where Australian standard of living will go down.
