Response to Interim Report

The National Insurance Brokers Association (NIBA) supports the general approach adopted in the Productivity Commission's Interim Report on *National Worker's Compensation and OH&S Frameworks*.

The need for a national approach to worker's compensation and OH&S has been obvious for some time. The Interim Report provides a workable means of achieving that important end.

Provided there is little delay with implementation of each step, the staged approach should mean that all corporate employers have access to national arrangements within a reasonable time frame.

NIBA strongly supports the idea of the Commonwealth establishing a broad-based national scheme for all corporate employers that would be underwritten by private sector insurers and incorporate a self-insurance scheme for employers that are able to satisfy certain prudential and other requirements.

The arrangements, when fully implemented, will mean that all corporate employers, both large and small will have increased options and choices available to them for handling their workers compensation responsibilities. The increased flexibility flowing from the proposed arrangements will encourage innovative behavior and more effective ways of dealing with all aspects of workers compensation and OH&S issues.
